Choosing Scriptures for your wedding?

How many Scriptures do you choose? 1, 2, 3 or more? That's entirely up to you. Remember as you put your wedding worship together, you are inviting God's presence and offering yourselves unto God - that is your worship. The Scripture passages you select should speak about marriage, family, relationships, or they might have a special meaning to you (Eg: some couples have chosen their confirmation verses.)



To make your service more personal you may also wish to involve others in your wedding worship service by asking friends, family members, or members of your wedding party to read the Scriptures you have selected. Have fun selecting your Scriptures! The following are just a few examples, but almost any Scripture selection you make will be appropriate for your wedding. Because *"All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It straightens us out and teaches us to do what is right. It is God's way of preparing us in every way, fully equipped for every good thing God wants us to do."* 2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NLT)
